Peak to Peak Student Shines at Intel International Science Competition

(Lafayette) Peak to Peak junior Gwyneth Glissmann of Boulder competed at the Intel International Science and Engineering Fair (Intel ISEF) in Atlanta, Georgia, based on her showing at the Roche Colorado Regional Science and Engineering Fair competition. The Intel ISEF is the world's largest international pre-college science competition, which provides an annual forum for more than 1,500 high school students from over 40 countries to showcase their independent research. It is the premiere science competition in the world exclusively for students in grades 9-12. The judging is by doctoral-level scientists, and students compete for nearly \$4 million in prizes and scholarships. Gwyneth had a strong showing with her project on combating the effects of global warming and received:

- United States Army Award of \$3,000,
- Office of Naval Research on behalf of the U.S. Navy and Marine Corps Award of \$8,000 scholarship,
- American Geological Institute Award of \$1,500,
- American Meteorological Society Award of \$2,000, and
- 4th Place Award of \$500
